Manh Choh Today

- Joint venture between Kinross and Contango, in partnership with the Native Village of Tetlin
- Mining scheduled to conclude in 2027
- Ore transport scheduled to conclude in 2028
- Safety remains our top priority for employees, contractors, and the public



Project Timeline


- **2008–2018:** Exploration and feasibility
- **2020:** Kinross becomes majority owner and honors existing agreements
- **2023:** Permits secured
- **2024:** First gold poured
- **2026:** Backfilling begins
- **2027:** Mining scheduled to conclude
- **2028:** Ore transport scheduled to conclude




Workforce & Transition
